A Whale of a Tale

Portland Advertiser & Gazette of Maine
November 13, 1838

(apparently a reprint from an item in the Saco Herald)

A Whale - One of the monsters of the deep, measuring upwards of sixty feet in length, was
adrift, dead as a herring, one day this week, by Mr. Norwood, keeper of the light on Wood
towed up the river to the foot of Factory Island, where he has been exhibited "free gratis for
all who would take the trouble to look at him. He is the fin-back species.
